1. The Council is invited to consider the documents TGP/4/1 Draft 10 "Constitution and Maintenance of Variety Collections", TGP/9/1 Draft 10 "Examining Distinctness", and BMT Guidelines (proj.9) "Guidelines for DNA-Profiling: Molecular Marker Selection and Database Construction ('BMT Guidelines')".
