RECRUITING OF A NEW VICE SECRETARY GENERAL

Report by the Secretary General

1. After the Consultative Working Committee had discussed, on October 9, 1973, the proposal of the Secretary General to elect the new Vice Secretary General from among the following candidates: Mr. H.J. Mast, Mr. S.E.G.A. Westberg, and Mr. H.K. Kaltenecker, it became clear that, for several reasons, the final decision could not be taken at the Council meeting to be held from October 10 to 12, 1973.
2. As a result of a decision by the Consultative Working Committee, the Secretary General proposes that the Council give the Consultative Working Committee the mandate to propose to the Swiss Government a new Vice Secretary General after interviews arranged by the Consultative Working Committee. In addition to the above-mentioned three candidates, the following two candidates should also be invited for interviews: Miss A.A.M. Boucher and Mr. J.W.R. Sanders.
3. The interviews should take place at the beginning of December 1973, on a date to be fixed later by the Secretary General in consultation with the Chairman or Vice Chairman of the Consultative Working Committee. It was recommended that the member States should be represented by a maximum of two delegates.
4. The interviews should take place in the morning and the candidates should be invited to present themselves at half-hourly intervals; the discussions of the Consultative Working Committee should take place and the decisions be made in the afternoon.
5. The Council is invited to delegate to the Consultative Working Committee the power to propose the candidate to be appointed to the post of Vice Secretary General according to the procedure described above.
